THE PALAU-YAP ADVANTAGE

- **Convenience and economics.** Continental offers flights to both destinations, so there are no added expenses of using another airline. The flight between Yap and Palau is only 45 minutes.
- **Sample different cultures.** While the islands are quite close, only 263 miles apart, the topography and cultures remain unique. Palau has taken advantage of many western advancements. Yap on the other hand is a quaint, quiet island, which deeply treasures and preserves its island heritage. Yap is also very safe. Visitors may browse the island's stone paths and famous Stone Money Banks.
- **Awesome diving!** Both island groups offer spectacular diving. (Palau is known for stronger currents.) Yap may be considered the manta capital of the world, but serious divers have sampled her fabulous macro treasures like her groups of mating Mandarin fish, Pegasus Sea Moths, frogfish and countless pipefish. Yap's outer walls also have some great shark action!
- **Yap's Mantas.** December to late April, the Mantas congregate in even greater numbers in Mi'l Channel for the mating season. During the summer season, they spend their mornings in Goofnuw Channel in the Valley of the Rays.

HOTEL/DIVE PACKAGE

Manta Ray Bay Hotel/Dive packages are a real value because everything is included and there are no additional taxes such as departure taxes, park fees or dive taxes. SUNDAY: Board the *Palau Aggressor II* and enjoy a week of diving.

SATURDAY: One morning dive aboard the *Palau Aggressor II*. Saturday evening check-out.

EARLY SUNDAY MORNING: Short flight to Yap.

SUNDAY MORNING: Greeted at the Yap airport and transferred in an air-conditioned bus to Manta Ray Bay Hotel, where you are immediately taken to your room.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON: Delicious lunch aboard the schooner S/V Mnuw followed by diving with Yap Divers.

SUNDAY -WEDNESDAY: Diving, snorkeling, island tours, kayak tours, fishing and much more.
