Aggressor Fleet Terms & Conditions

Deposit Policy:

Individuals: 40% of the charter rate is due within 14 days of the reservation. Final payment is due ninety (90) days prior to departure.

Groups (1/2 boat or more): A non-refundable, non transferable deposit of \$1500 accompanied by a signed contract is required within 14 days of the reservation. Reservation will only be confirmed with signed contract.

Aggressor Fleet Cruise Application/Waiver Policy: The Cruise Application/Waiver, found under 'Downloads', must be fully completed, signed (digitally or manually) and received by the Reservations Center (90) days prior to departure date. Many Aggressor destinations are required to submit passenger information for itinerary approval. Passengers who fail to comply will be canceled and denied boarding. If a reservation is made (90) days or less prior to the charter date, completed and signed Cruise Application Waiver must accompany full payment in accordance with the payment policies to confirm reservation.

Final Documents Package: Upon receipt of your final payment, your **final documents package** will be mailed to you. This package contains luggage tags which will help the crew identify your bags. Prior to your departure, please download a current "**Know Before You Go**" by going to www.aggressor.com to the "Download" section of the website. You will not receive a voucher as proof of payment for the charter. Visit www.aggressor.com to view the Captains log for water temperature and sittings.

The following information is important.

ARRIVAL & BOARDING THE BOAT

If you arrive in Grand Cayman prior to 12:00 noon on the day of your charter, you will need to make your own way to the boat. Guests arriving after 12:00 noon in

Grand Cayman on the day of their charter will be met at the airport by a uniformed crewmember.

Cayman taxi regulations do not allow the crew to transfer you to the boat; however, they will assist you with your luggage. If you are already on the island, please make your way to the Cayman Aggressor IV, anytime after 2:00 p.m. on Saturday. The Cayman Aggressor IV, docks at the George Town Tourist Dock, however, during the winter months, she occasionally docks off Ann Drive in North Sound Estates. To confirm if the boat will be docked at the George Town Tourist Dock or in North Sound Estates, you may call the Cayman Aggressor office Friday between 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. at +1-345-949-5551, the office cell at +1-345-916-3237 or the boat cell +1-345-916-1422. The Reservations Center emergency cell phone is +1-985-714-1300.

We highly recommend you pack a swimsuit, change of clothes, toiletries and any medication you may need in your carry-on bag. Having these few items with you can make an unexpected luggage delay more bearable.

CAYMAN DIVING CONDITIONS

You will be diving in water that averages 78° - 82°. Most guests make as many as 5 dives each day, so some sort of protection is needed. A 3mm wetsuit or shorty is recommended. Gloves are not permitted when diving due to local regulations. All diving is directly from the mother ship.

PASSPORTS, DOCUMENTATION, C-CARDS, AND DIVE THE WORLD CLUB

Visitors must have a current passport, adequate funds to support themselves, and a return airline ticket to travel to the Cayman Islands. US citizens are required to have a passport which must be valid for 6 months from date of entry. It is the travelers' responsibility to ensure they have the proper documentation to travel to the destination and return to their country. Please check with the appropriate consulate to ensure you have the proper documentation. Always check your passport and visa requirements. US citizens may go to the US Department of State website at www.travel.state.gov for more information. *The Reservation Center cannot assume responsibility for passengers not having correct documentation.*

Remember to bring your C-card or proof of certification. The divemaster requires proof of certification before the first dive.



If you are a repeat guest you are automatically enrolled in Aggressor Fleet's Dive the World Club and will receive 10% off on-board services.



WAIVER & INSURANCE

The Reservation Center and the Cayman Aggressor IV require each guest to complete a Cruise Application and waiver form at least (90) days prior to departure. Many Aggressors have to submit passenger information in advance for itinerary approval. You may complete one online by going to www.aggressor.com.

We highly recommend scuba divers purchase a travel insurance policy through DiveAssure, Divers Alert Network or a policy of your choice. For coverage information, go to: www.aggressor.com.

In the event a flight is delayed or missed, please call the boat direct or leave a message on the office cell phone if you cannot contact the boat. The yacht is equipped with a computer and e-mail access via satellite phone. Once onboard, phone cards can be purchased for satellite phone calls and incoming/outgoing e-mails.

SHIPS BOUTIQUE & CREDIT CARDS

There is a mini-boutique onboard with assorted t-shirts, shorts, batteries and miscellaneous items. Due to the uncertainty of availability in Cayman, we highly recommend you bring extra batteries and supplies you may need. The Cayman Aggressor IV accepts cash, Travelers Checks, Discover, Visa, MasterCard & AMEX. Sorry, no personal checks.

FRIDAY

Friday afternoon, the Cayman Aggressor IV returns to George Town to provision and fuel the yacht. This is your opportunity to shop or sightsee. The Cayman Aggressor IV hosts a sunset cocktail party Friday evening at 6:00 p.m. The crew will assist you in recommending dinner at a local Caymanian restaurant in town.

CREW GRATUITY

Gratuities should be voluntary and based upon the quality of service the crew has provided. When settling your account on the final day of the receipt, the Captain will have an envelope for gratuities that will be divided equally among the crew.

CHECKOUT

If you don't have plans to extend your stay in the Cayman Islands, we recommend an early a.m. morning departure. Check out time is between 7:00 and 8:00 a.m. Saturday. The crew will transport you to the airport or to your hotel, in the George Town area. Day rooms are available at several local hotels.

SATURDAY: Afternoon arrivals are met at the airport and transferred to the Cayman Aggressor IV. At 6:00 p.m. dinner is served on board followed by the Captain's briefing then welcome party.

SUNDAY-THURSDAY: Eat, Sleep, Dive aboard the Cayman Aggressor IV.

FRIDAY: Diving ends Friday at approximately noon. The Cayman Aggressor IV returns to port. 6:00 p.m. cocktail party on board. 7:00 p.m. dinner at a local restaurant.

SATURDAY: 8:00 a.m. checkout. Guests transferred to airport.



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
