Aggressor Fleet Terms and Conditions:

Deposit Policy:

Individuals: 40% of the charter rate is due within 14 days of the reservation. Final payment is due ninety (90) days prior to departure.

Groups (1/2 boat or more): A non-refundable, non transferable deposit of \$1500 accompanied by a signed contract is required within 14 days of the reservation. Reservation will only be confirmed with signed contract.

Aggressor Fleet Cruise Application/Waiver Policy: The Cruise Application/Waiver found on our website under 'Downloads' must be fully completed, signed (digitally or manually) and received by the Reservations Center at least ninety (90) days prior to departure date. Many Aggressor destinations are required to submit passenger information for itinerary approval. Passengers who fail to comply will be canceled and denied boarding. If a reservation is made (90) days or less prior to the charter date, completed and signed Cruise Application Waiver must accompany full payment in accordance with the payment policies to confirm reservation.

Final Documents Package: Upon receipt of your final payment, you will receive a **final documents package**. This package will include luggage tags which will help the crew identify your bags. Prior to your departure, please download a current "**Know Before You Go**" by going to www.aggressor.com to the "Download" section of the website. You will not receive a voucher as proof of payment for the charter.

ARRIVAL & BOARDING THE BOAT

The Fiji Aggressor II docks at the Fisheries Jetty, adjacent to the Tradewinds Hotel in Suva. All charters depart from Suva and transportation will be

provided from and to the Suva (SUV) airport. Pick up from the Suva airport will be at 10:30 a.m. for transfer to the Fiji Aggressor II. (30-45 minute ride)

Guests staying in the outer island resorts should make sure that their flights to Suva are booked for the early morning as the yachts leave at 1:00 pm to cruise to the night anchorage about 8 hours from Suva. They should also contact the Suva Office and leave information on the name of their resort and time of arrival. The driver will be holding a "Fiji Aggressor II" sign. If you fly from an outer resort or, are staying at a resort, you will be responsible for cab fare to the Tradewinds Hotel. The bus transportation on the day of arrival from the Suva Airport is included in the charter price as well as departure back to the airport. Diving begins Sunday morning.

FIJI DIVING CONDITIONS

You will be diving in water that averages 75°- 80°F. Most guests make as many as 5 dives each day, so some sort of protection is needed. A 5mm wetsuit with skin suit, booties and gloves are recommended.

- October and November:** peak conditions – 100' + visibility and 80°F water temperature.
- December to April:** wet season – clear mornings with afternoon rain, 60' – 80' visibility and 85°F water temperature.
- May to September:** - 100' + visibility and 78°F water temperature. It is possible to have periods of strong trade winds and isolated showers during these months.

All diving is from the dive tender. Please see the "Captain's Log" on the Aggressor website for current diving conditions.

PASSPORTS, DOCUMENTATION, C-CARDS, AND DIVE THE WORLD CLUB

Visitors must have a current passport, adequate funds to support themselves, and a return airline ticket to travel to Fiji. United States citizens require a passport which must be valid for six months from date of entry. It is the travelers' responsibility to ensure they have the proper documentation to travel to the destination and return to their country. Please check with the appropriate consulate to ensure you have the proper documentation. Always check your passport and visa requirements. US citizens may go to the US Department of State website at www.travel.state.gov for more information. **The Reservations Center cannot assume responsibility for passengers not having correct documentation.**

Remember to bring your C-card or proof of certification. The divemaster requires proof of certification before the first dive. If you are a repeat guest you are automatically entered in Aggressor Fleet's Dive the World Club and will receive 10% off on-board services.

WAIVER & INSURANCE

The Reservations Center and the Fiji Aggressor II require each guest to complete an application and waiver form, prior to departure and diving. Please visit our web site, www.aggressor.com, and go to 'Downloads' and you will be able to complete and email it to fiji@aggressor.com. We highly recommend that guests purchase travel & dive accident insurance.

SHIPS BOUTIQUE AND CREDIT CARDS

There is a mini-boutique onboard with assorted t-shirts, shorts, batteries and miscellaneous items. We highly recommend you bring extra batteries and supplies that you may need. The Fiji Aggressor II accepts cash, Visa, American Express and MasterCard. Many credit card companies are charging a conversion fee. If this happens to you, please contact your credit card company.

FRIDAY

The Fiji Aggressor II returns to port at approximately 3:00 p.m. Friday afternoon after one morning dive. The Captain and crew host an evening cocktail party. The crew will recommend dinner at a local restaurant.

TAXES & FEES

The Fijian Government charges a VAT Tax of \$150 per person. There is a \$15 park fee to protect Kubulau's Namena Barrier Reef and a 17.5 VAT tax for onboard purchases. These can all be paid by cash, VISA, MC or American Express.

CREW GRATUITY

Gratuities are voluntary and based upon the quality of service the crew has provided. When settling your account on the final day of the trip, the Captain will have an envelope for gratuities that will be divided equally among the crew. Due to Fiji taxes, the crew can only accept cash for crew gratuities.

CHECKOUT

Check-out time is Saturday morning at 7:30 a.m. The bus to the Suva Airport departs at approximately 7:30 a.m. Saturday. If you are extending your stay, arrangements can be made for transportation to your local hotel; additional charges will apply.
